

# HONG KONG LOCAL MARKETS HOPPER

## (PRIVATE TOUR)

Hong Kong is packed full of fascinating markets and all these markets are colorful and lively, absolutely a must on any visit. It's not only a great place for shoppers to "go shopping" but also a kaleidoscope for photographers. Let's explore the best of Hong Kong's lively markets on this half-day walking tour.

For private tour, our friendly local guide will meet you at the hotel lobby for the starting of our walking tour and take MTR to Prince Edward station.

We kick this tour off on a fragrant note at the Flower Market, a jungle of colorful flowers, fragrant scents and luck-bringing houseplants spread out over 50 shops, it's the perfect introduction to the markets in Kowloon.

Right next to the fragrant Flower Market is the sonorous Yuen Po Street Bird Garden, a charming Chinese-style garden where you will hear melodious chirping from the hundreds of birds in more than 70 songbird stalls. You will see the elderlies carry their beloved birdies in intricate cages.



Now, it's time to practice or to show your bargaining skills when we head on over Fa Yuen Street – a popular non-touristy local street market where vendors sell bargain-priced clothes, bags, accessories and other household items. If you're not up for bargaining, it's still tons of fun to experience the atmosphere of the market, set deep within the neighbourhood of Mong Kok - the world's most densely populated neighborhood with more than 130,000 people per square kilometer!



Before we head out down Nathan Road, passing by the five-star Langham Place hotel and mall, then we reach Shanghai Street to get a glimpse of the street famous for selling traditional Chinese wedding clothes, ancestral offerings and feng shui items.

Continue onto the Yau Ma Tei Theatre, the oldest existing theater in Kowloon, built and used as a cinema since the 1930s but now turned into a Chinese Opera House.

In here, we'll head into the Yau Ma Tei fruit market, a century-old wholesale market that sells exotic fruits from all over the world, runs 24 hours a day 7 days a week.

From there, we'll also call by the world-famous Jade Market, which has more than 400 stalls selling jade pendants, bracelets and ornaments to learn why the Chinese believe jade wards off evil spirits.

The final stop on this walking tour of Kowloon's markets is a visit to Temple Street market, the liveliest night market in Hong Kong. Find bargain electronic goods, try the savory treats from one of the many open-air food stands or visit a feng shui advisor. You will also catch an impromptu Cantonese opera show, this all adds to the lively and bustling atmosphere of the market.



## DETAILS

**DURATION OF TOUR :** 4-5 hours (Approx)

**MEETING PLACE :** Very Flexible – We will pick you up at your hotel or some other plans before the tour we will come and meet you somewhere.

**STARTING TIME:** 1:30 pm

**FINISHING PLACE:** Very Flexible – our tour guide will keep you accompanied to your hotel or anywhere else in down town you planned.

## NOTES :

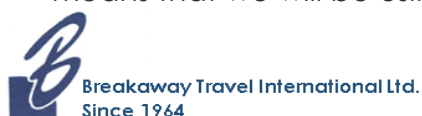
- Above prices are the **TOTAL price** for the tour but **NOT** the price per person.
