SMALL GROUP WANCHAI FOODIE TOUR



Why we choose Wanchai as our foodie stop? Wanchai is a fascinating old neighborhood packed with so much diversity, very rich in history, traditional and legendary, varieties of great food. This area has become a gourmet neighborhood of International cuisines, consisting of design-driven lifestyle restaurants to the alleyway hidden small local food stalls, from the world renowned comfort foods to the classic street foods.

Wanchai, being one of the oldest neighborhoods, has been intensely developed in the last 2 decades, old buildings coexist with modern architectures. The vintage buildings remind us the past of Hong Kong while the modern skyscraper shows us the city's journey of the 21st century. Our foodie guide will regale you with the history of Wanchai and share fun facts with you, learn more of Hong Kong's food culture and history of development.

Our friendly foodie guide will meet you at the MTR station, say at 10hr30 in the morning. We begin our tour with a tasty sampling brunch at a local “Hong Kong style café” (Cha Chang Teng) for the iconic drinks like milk tea or mixed milk tea and coffee, Hong Kong style French toast, pineapple bun with fresh butter, breakfast sandwiches and other morning specialties.



Want to dig deeply to the grassroots Hong Kong character? In between our tastings, we will stop by an iconic wet market that offer a blast to the past. Wet markets are the traditional places that sell poultry, live fish, fresh meat which require frequent "floor washing", this is how the name of "wet market" came from. Wet markets are usually wet, smelly and fishy but also the places to get freshest food with cheapest prices. Vegetables, fruits, cooked food stuffs and dried goods are also available there but these sections are separate from the fish and meal stalls.

At the market, we usually stop at two or three family-run tasting food stalls featuring Hong Kong's classic food which may include samples of roast pork belly, snake soup and the marvelous egg puffs, egg tarts from the local bakery.



On our way, we will pay a visit to the "Blue House" which was the original site for the first hospital in 1870's but was acquired by the government in 1970's, and the outer walls painted blue and was thus named the "Blue House". The building has been preserved and revitalized in a traditional tea and medicine style. There are still residents occupying the structure despite a lack of modern conveniences such as flush toilets.

By the time you've sampled different food for brunch, will you feel like a local with new knowledge of Hong Kong's culinary culture? We want to space your tastings, so you can still have space in case if you have any further lunch plan.

BOOKING & CANCELLATION

- **Booking has to be made at least 5 days prior to the tour date**

 - **No show :** 100% of tour fees are paid
 - **Cancellation made within 48 hours prior to the tour date :** 100% of tour fees are paid
 - **Cancellation made more than 48 hours prior to the tour date :** 25% of the tour fees are paid

PRICING : HKD780 PER PAX (REQUIRE MINIMUM 2 ADULTS TO OPERATE THE TOUR)

- Children under 12 years old are free.
- Children aged 12 or above is considered as a full paying person.
- Maximum 2 children (age 0-11 years old) can be accompanied by 2 paying adults
- **Remarks :**
 - Minimum of 2 participants are required to operate a tour. There is a possibility of cancellation after confirmation if there are not enough passengers to meet requirements.
 - If this is occurring, your guests will be offered an alternative or full refund
